

Why Our Governments Think Aliens Are Real

Honestly, what is happening in the world today? Why are we abandoning everything we know to be wholesome and good for the sake of a thriller movie or game? So let me be perfectly clear about this subject of aliens, extra-terrestrial monsters, or for that matter any life form other than on planet Earth. *There is no evidence what-so-ever in all of the research done by all of the space agencies around the world that points a finger at any of these things existing.* Let me re-state that so you really grasp what is actual reality. There is no evidence what-so-ever of any life forms in the cosmos. There is only misguided speculation and just plain lies that pass as the fiction of science and herein we think that this is somehow okay.

But if the hate preaching against God and anyone who professes their faith in Him is dressed up in a different guise that appeals in looks to society but still preaches that underlying hate message through re-direction, that message is not seen as an act of vilification.

All mainstream Christian believers and all Jewish believers hold that God created the heavens and the earth and all things in the outer space of our universe. Without God's ex-nihilo creation no thing that exists today would exist. The universe is solely purposed to accommodate a terrestrial place upon which mankind would inhabit for a period of time.

Every Christian believer should know that there is a purpose for mankind being on this planet and God has not created (nor would permit) any non-Earth bound life form to interfere with His grand Plan for mankind's redemption to an everlasting spiritual life in heaven. This is God's sole purpose for Earth's existence, and the universe is the sole purpose for the Earth's accommodation. I was interested by a couple of articles written by journalist Kelly Dickerson in 2016 where she surveyed a number of Astro-scientists and physicists about the existence of alien life forms in the outer regions of the universe. It was most revealing. The survey revealed three under-girding fundamentals behind science's strong stance on the subject of aliens in the universe. They are:

- (1) If life arose naturally on Earth then it could have happened on other planets. (Jason Wright)
- (2) If it is true that life is a common outcome of chemistry, then it is a good bet that this process is happening on other worlds. (Debra Fisher)
- (3) It is a simple numbers game. There are estimated to be up to 100 billion stars in each of the estimated 3 trillion galaxies across just the known areas of the universe. The number of galaxies across the whole of the universe will never be known. Therefore if there is life on planet Earth there must be life elsewhere. (A commonly quoted scientific view)

If you don't hold and exercise a belief in God then these above articles of logic are very compelling on the mind. Without the foundation of the knowledge of God there is little opposition to adopting them as your alternative premise of belief. We can see that governments are perversely persuaded to become involved in these numbers games and the underlying quest for power and glory in the name of science.

Two very well credentialed Astro-scientists testified to the U.S. Congress in 2014 that there is "close to 100% chance" that aliens exist. One of these fellows also stated that "It would be bizarre if we were alone". Another very well credentialed scientist said NASA is "following the water" in the solar system to search for signs of life. This particular statement is very myopic in its logic (which should have been immediately picked up) and perhaps is indicative of Science at the highest levels not really grasping the broad latitude of life as it is

already. I of course refer to God's spiritual domain of angels and other heavenly beings that do not require terrestrial water molecules to live.

But all is not entirely lost. Occasionally a breath of truth surfaces and one can only just have pity on how the blind can lead the blind about aliens in our world. And this is no pun. If you are blind and cannot see or hear any aliens nor find any evidence of their existence, how do you convince another blind person that they are out there? I won't answer this, but once you understand this scenario your eyes will be opened.

However, one of the other scientists at NASA who was also surveyed by Ms Dickerson said the following. "*More evidence is needed before anyone can say anything beyond mere speculation*" in reference to alien life forms existing in the universe. And this is the absolute shocking truth of the matter.

So why are the governments of the world so committed to spending huge amounts of money on searching for comic book fictional alien creatures? Very clearly the scientific community has a vested interest in having funds thrown at them for any research project – real or fictional, it apparently doesn't really matter. Being an unemployed scientist is a bad place to be. Where can you get a job? Who wants you?

But because there is a willingness for governments to undertake such risky and costly exploration into outer space we can clearly come to two conclusions. Firstly, perhaps they are not really looking for aliens at all, they are searching for rare and valuable mineral resources that will give them superior powers over other nations and are selling this to a gullible public via a populous fictional theme. Secondly and probably more nearer the truth, we can clearly see that despite public comments to the contrary, the leaders of our modern world just don't have the Christian faith to believe that God created the heavens and the earth and all things therein. These poor souls are left only with listening to those who serve under them in office.
