Genesis 14:18 “And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.” King Melchisedec came out and met Abraham on the outskirts of Salem (early Jerusalem) after Abraham rescued Lot and all his household from Chedorlaomer the king of Elam and his ally Kings that went to war. Also see Hebrews Chapters Six and Seven for an understanding of why the Levitical priesthood of Aaron has ceased and the priesthood of Melchisedec will last forever. Hebrews 8:7-8 “For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second. For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:”

2. Judges 14:5-9 and 14:12-14 Having rent and killed a lion, he passed by the carcass sometime after this and observed that there was a swarm of bees and honey in the carcass of the lion.

3. Nahum 1:15 The minor prophet Nahum
