

Revisiting Genesis

Introduction

This is a short article discussing the pitfalls of misinterpretation of God's written word. In particular it focusses on the Book of Genesis and reveals that these passages are ancient song lines that have been handed down the generations from the period of Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden until Moses and his scribes were charged with the task of introducing the written modality of communication to the fledgling nation of Israel.
